Rules and Guidelines

- The minor in political science requires a minimum of five courses in political science.
- Barnard College courses may fulfill Columbia minor requirements; however, BC courses do not follow the Columbia numbering system and cannot be used to determine the subfield within which a course falls.
- No more than two courses may double-count for two separate majors/concentrations/minors or programs.
- A maximum of one course in political science may be transferred from other institutions, including no more than one AP course. Transfer credits must be approved by the undergraduate adviser or the Director of Undergraduate Studies (DUS).
- Students must receive a grade of at least C- in order for a course to count towards the minor.
- A grade of "Pass" is acceptable for only the FIRST course taken for the minor.
